▶ **THE BEACH HOUSE, BARBUDA** — Escape to paradise and unwind at the Beach House in Barbuda, one of the Caribbean's secluded island gems. This chic European-designed boutique hotel, with just 21 rooms, is a hot new hideaway that offers the best in high-end luxury and sophisticated privacy. Sun on the pink-sand beach, take a dip in the seawater pool, or have your personal butler arrange for snorkeling, diving, fishing, horseback riding, or excursions to the island's bird sanctuary or tropical jungle. The Beach House is also an ideal location for a destination wedding. Honeymoon packages start at \$1,420 per oceanview suite per night, and include a champagne breakfast, a candlelight dinner, and massages. 888-776-0333; www.thebeachhousebarbuda.com.

▶ **SARATOGA SPRINGS RESORT AND SPA, ORLANDO** — For a step back in time to the Victorian lakeside horse-racing community in upstate New York, unwind at Disney's newest resort. This 552-villa, 65-acre resort is surrounded by the Lake Buena Vista Golf Course and is just one of two Disney resorts to offer a spa onsite. Saratoga Springs also features a themed pool with a natural-springs-inspired pool slide, along with whirlpool spas, quiet pools, and tennis, basketball, and shuffleboard courts. The Downtown Disney area, with its dining and nightlife, is just a short walk or boat ride away. And the theme parks are accessible by bus or water launch. ▶ **TURTLE BAY RESORT, HAWAII** — If you're envisioning Hawaii's legendary big surf as the backdrop for your honeymoon, check into Oahu's 880-acre Turtle Bay Resort, the actual outdoor location for Fox's hit show, "The North Shore." Forty-two luxury beach cottages rim the beachfront, while 401 rooms are situated in the six-story hotel, located adjacent to Kuilima Cove, one of the best swimming and snorkeling spots on the island. Every room boasts an unobstructed view of the Pacific. Take surfing lessons at the resort's Hans Hedemann surfing school, enjoy horseback rides along the beach, rejuvenate at the spa, or spend the day at one of the two championship golf courses.
